John Gabriel is Senior Lecturer in Musicology at the Melbourne Conservatorium of Music. His research focusses on the music and culture of German- and Czech-speaking Central Europe from the fin-de-siècle to the early Cold War. Recent publications include articles on China in the German musical imaginary and radio music theatre in Weimar Republic Germany, as well as the edited volume *Australasian Music at Home and Abroad*. He is currently completing a book on the music theatre of the New Objectivity. Before arriving at Melbourne, he held academic appointments at the University of Hong Kong and the Peabody Conservatory at Johns Hopkins University. He completed his PhD at Harvard University and holds an MA in Musikwissenschaft from the Freie Universität Berlin.
